Parking

At the start of the new academic year, it is a good time to remind our parents of the need to park carefully and considerately within our car park. Your child's safety and security is of paramount importance. Please could we remind you to comply with these simple guidelines in order to protect each and every one of us and to avoid car park congestion.

- Please drive slowly up and down Flux's Lane and throughout the car park. Please do not drive the wrong way up the car park. There is a maximum speed limit of 5 miles per hour.
- The drop and go area is intended for children who are old enough to find their own way to the classroom. Children from Years 3 to 6 are expected to use this.
- Due to car park congestion, we would ask you to depart promptly from the car park after dropping off your child.
- No parking in the middle of the car park blocking cars parked on the right.
- Please remember we have neighbours in Flux's Lane who should be considered. Could all parents please park only within our grounds – **there should be no parking in Flux's Lane, either up the hill or adjacent to the front gates where no parking signs are displayed.** Further space is available along the exit lane if the car park is full. Please advise the office should you need to leave your car for any length of time in our car park and give them your registration number. Your car should, if possible, be parked in the far car park away from the main building.

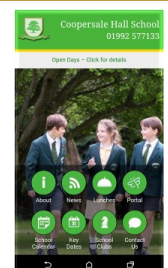
Children in Year 1D enjoyed a visit from Year 5 pupils who spent time reading to the younger children.

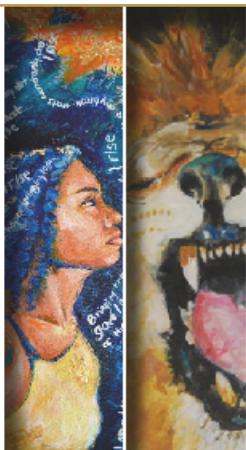
